ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

A NOTE FROM ALYSA PERRERAS



Over a decade in education, my work is driven by the question, "what does it mean to be free"?". I began my journey exploring this question as a classroom teacher, learning, laughing and growing alongside high school students in the literature classroom for eight years. In the IGPE program, I was able to expand my craft as I expanded my understanding of creativity, innovation and collaborative learning communities from the professor's in my master's program.

In the last five years, my work has expanded to include curriculum design, adult learning, strategic planning and educational and justice centered lens...

I have provided consulting services and professional learning on anti bias and antiracist practices with international schools throughout Latin America and have presented on the work of equity and liberated education at various conferences around the globe. I combine my own lived experiences as a biracial, multicultural woman and the intentional study of the practitioners of abolition and liberation who have come before me to bring an intersectional lens into all the work I do.

While in the IGPE program, I was given the opportunity to travel to Buffalo and learn directly from SUNY professors and other educators teaching in Buffalo public schools. This experience deepened my thinking around teaching through a culturally sustaining lens and offered an in-depth experience that allowed me to engage with an intersectional educational praxis.

In my current practice, I continue to partner with educational communities to inspire social change rooted in justice and liberation by offering data-driven, personalized, and ongoing professional learning experiences. I often rely on systems thinking pedagogy to cultivate and maintain organizational cultures that live into the practices of equity and antiracism. Educational thought leaders, professors and friends I met through the IGPE program continue to form a part of the system of people in my life who support me in being the best version of myself as an educator and consulting, all through an anti bias, antiracist human committed to more just, liberated and humanity centered learning communities.
